 - 2. To those who are perishing, an aroma of eternal death
 - C. Jesus Christ makes us Sufficient [2 Cor 3:5-6]
 - D. Serving the People God has given me to love [John 13:1-17] including those I do not Yet Know [1 Pe 2:11-12]
 - E. I am called to serve, not to be served [Mark 10:45]
